1. Database

Name of Program:

Database

Short Description of Program:

The database work program aimed to simplify the collection of student data in Sweden. Data was collected by completing surveys and checking in with the regional coordinator on a regular basis. The number of new students, active students during management, and alumni were all counted when data was gathered.

When the Program was held:

The program ran from May 2021 to April 2022, during the management period.

Reflection on the Program:

The data collected is divided into three categories: new students who arrived in Sweden in 2021 (up to 84), active students in 2021/2022 (up to 166), and students who graduated and left Sweden (up to 70). The most difficult aspect of implementing this program was:

- Reaching out to new students who did not have access to PPI Sweden's social media.
- Updating regularly due to study activities.
- Sudden data requests.

Improvement for the Future:

In the future, it is hoped that data collection will be done more regularly by approaching the regional coordinator personally and with a more frequent update frequency. Data that is constantly updated will make it easier to respond to a sudden data request.

2. PPI Swedia Instagram Ambassador

Name of Program:

PPI Swedia Instagram Ambassador

Short Description of Program:

Through this program, PPI Swedia communicates and helps prospective students by sharing real stories of Indonesian students in Sweden and many relevant information about studying in Sweden. Twenty seven instagram ambassadors from various areas in Sweden were selected to take over PPI Swedia's Instagram account regularly. Many topics related to study in Sweden have been covered in the feed posts and IG TV, and the Instagram ambassadors also communicated with the audiences through comments and direct messages. As of June 20, 2022, PPI Swedia has more than 13.000 followers on Instagram.

When the Program was held:

Under the period of 2021-2022.

Reflection on the Program:

The ambassadors have been very active and informative in sharing information and assisting the prospective students who wants to study in Sweden through Instagram. Many areas of topic have been covered and discussed.

Improvement for the Future:

Since Instagram has introduced some new features on the platform, it would be better that future ambassadors take advantage of the new features, such as reels, and maximize the visibility of the contents.

So far the topics covered in the vlogs are diverse and sufficient to give an overview of various students' life in Sweden to prospective students.


Improvement for the Future:

4. Popular Science Conference

Name of Program:

Popular Science Conference Vol. 1 & 2

When the Program was held:

- Vol. 1: May 30, 2021
- Vol. 2: April 2, 2022

Reflection on the Program:


This book year is the first time this program was held. As the diversity of the presenter's domain and the current pandemic situation, the program was held online via zoom. The first volume showed 5 research coming from diverse fields of study and from 4 different areas in Sweden (Skåne, Uppsala, Stockholm, and Gothenburg), out of 6 presenters who registered. Throughout the event there was in total 95 people joining the meeting room, and 65 audience attending the whole program in average. The second volume showed 6 research coming from diverse fields of study and from 4 different areas in Sweden (Skåne, Uppsala, Stockholm, and Gothenburg), out of 7 presenters who registered. As many as 67 audiences registered to the event.

The documentation of the first volume was missing due to the unstable internet connection of two people recording the event. The language of the speakers was sometimes not understandable by the people who do not possess any relevant background of knowledge. Hence, these evaluations are accommodated by the second volume. The people recording the event had stable internet connection so that the documentation can be uploaded to PPI Swedia's YouTube channel. To tackle the second issue, PPI Swedia also had held a presentation rehearsal a few days before the event. Even though one presenter did not attend the rehearsal at all, the language used by the presenters were more understandable. It was proven by the fact that all presenters obtained questions from the audience with the same amount.

Improvement for the Future:

Different from the first event, the second event was held in the middle of the master's thesis timeline, in most universities in Sweden. The presenters who were potential to register sometimes hesitate to present their research as they had not finished the study yet. In this period the audience was also too focused on doing their assignments or their own master's thesis. In addition to that, this second event was held in the first day of fasting month, so it could also become one of the causes of the decrease in the people attending the D-day. For the future event, the timing of the event could replicate the first event, when every presenter mostly has finished their research.

In the second event, PPI Swedia already tried to interest the potential presenters who are still in their first year of study. They could present what they have been studying in their major, as there are some fields that are still unavailable in Indonesia but have been available in Sweden. However, there is still no first-year student registered to the event. It could be better if this can also be emphasized during the promotion of the event.



5. Webinar – Creative Content

Short Description of Program:

- Webinar 1: Webinar with the Indonesian Minister of Tourism and Creative Economy, Mr. Sandiaga Uno along with the Ambassador of Indonesia in the Kingdom of Sweden and Republic of Latvia, Mr. Kamapradipta Isnomo which reached almost 800 registrants. This webinar aimed to provide information and education to the general public, especially the Indonesian people in Sweden who are currently studying, regarding the direction of the Indonesian government's policy in supporting the growth of individuals and organizations capable of innovating in their respective fields.
- Webinar 2: Webinar with two President Directors of the State-Owned Enterprises Ministry (Soleh Ayubi & Iqbal Fikri) and the Special Staff of the ministry (Arya Sinulingga). Ambassador of Indonesia in the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Latvia, Mr. Kamapradipta Isnomo also attended the webinar for the opening speech. This webinar aimed to provide an overview and inspiration for students to equip themselves to become future leaders of Indonesia by inviting young leaders of the State-Owned Enterprises Ministry.



Reflection on the Program:


- For both webinars: The process of sending the webinar link and certificate was a bit disorganized.
- Webinar 1: there was no clear job description during the event, for example there was not clear who was supposed to handle the QnA session both in Zoom and YouTube.
- Webinar 2: the time span from the confirmation of the speakers to the event was only a week, giving us a very short time to prepare, publish the information about the event, and invite the Ambassador of Indonesia in the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Latvia, Mr. Kamapradipta Isnomo for the opening speech.
- The number of registered and attending participants differed significantly. Also, many of them only attend the event for a minute or two.

Improvement for the Future:

- Use the Zoom registration platform to send out webinar links and to get participants' emails to match the attendance list to send out certificates.
- We want to invite more female speakers to inspire Indonesia's young generation who is studying in Sweden.
- We have to figure out the best mechanism to sort the participants who deserve a certificate.
- We have to set a maximum time limit for speaker to confirm their attendance

6. From Sweden to Indonesia

Name of Program:

Dari Swedia untuk Indonesia (From Sweden to Indonesia)

Short Description of Program:

This program, which translates as 'from Sweden to Indonesia' is aimed to share the good news and things that can be learned from Sweden that hopefully can be applied in Indonesia. This includes cycling in Sweden, weather in Sweden, and learning Swedish in Sweden. We had chosen 10 writers consisting of Indonesians in Sweden and Indonesian who have lived or studied in Sweden. We provided a workshop by inviting a senior editor in one of the biggest newspaper outlets in Indonesia, Mr Lestantya R. When the Program was held:

- Workshop: 17 July 2021
- The articles writing process: throughout 2021

Reflection on the Program:

Despite having ten articles on various topics, we could not reach any newspaper outlet to publish our articles.

Improvement for the Future:

It seems like we have to send our articles directly to the editor of the newspaper outlet. We are going to keep contacting editors to publish our articles.

7. Partnership with Etude Edu Indonesia

Name of Program:

Partnership with Etude Edu Indonesia (Karir dan Kewirausahaan Committee)

Short Description of Program:

The program is a collaboration and partnership program with one scholarship and education consultant based in Indonesia (Etude Edu Indonesia). The partnership includes cooperation on recruitment information for PPI Swedia members who wish to join Etude through a mentorship program. From this program, an MoU stipulates how the partnership is carried out and what the rights and obligations of each party (PPI Swedia and Etude) are as long as this agreement is in effect.

When the Program was held:

The cooperation agreement with Etude was signed and approved by both parties in June 2022. The result was that several students and members of PPI Swedia became mentors at Etude Education and the program started in September 2021 and ended in March 2022. The MoU is valid for one year with an extension according to the agreement for an undetermined time and cooperation can continue if there are no changes in it.

Reflection on the Program:

The program was carried out well, but the MoU apart from recruitment as a mentor also regulates the existence of events organized by both parties. However, collaboration only stops at the recruitment program and no follow-up events have been held.

Improvement for the Future:

A follow-up event is needed between the two parties so that they can be more active and have more comprehensive benefits.

The event ran smoothly with participants not only from the PPI Swedia management but also from students outside the board. The event lasted for about an hour and was fun but very rewarding.

When the Program was held:

September 9, 2021

Reflection on the Program:

The good event was not matched by good publications so the number of participants could not be followed by all members of the PPI Swedia. Thus, it needs to be improved in terms of communication networks and broadcasts for each event.

Improvement for the Future:

Actually, there are a lot of Indonesian citizens who have careers in Sweden, therefore besides webinars, more practical skills can be done, for example,

workshops on how to write a good motivation letter and discuss with each other so that they can be mutually corrected.

Reflection on the Program:


1. The publications and broadcasts about the event are still an obstacle in this program, from a total of 80 participants who registered, there were less than 50 people who attended this event. Even though there are quite many participants, it can still be improved.

2. The talk was held successfully, with 68 people registered and around 30 attendees on that day. The panelists deliver their topic clearly, we led the discussion smoothly, and the audience also engaged in the QnA session.

Improvement for the Future:

- 1. If we are going to hold an event, it is necessary to plan the topic and speakers well in advance so that preparations are made more mature and the event can be attended by more participants.
- 2. Planning should be carefully managed to book the schedule, panelists availability, and make a thorough Terms of Reference. The certificates must be made and delivered sooner. More talks should be organized, since originally, we targeted that we would hold 2-3 talks in a year.

10. Talk-A-Pedia (PPI Swedia Podcast)

Name of Program:

Talk-A-Pedia

Short Description of Program:

Talk-A-Pedia is a new program of PPI Swedia. The goal of the program is two: to inform and to entertain. Hence, the idea is to make a podcast with topics regarding studying in Sweden in a more casual way. By doing so, the listeners could listen to the podcast and gain information in their spare time. For example, listening to the podcast while doing their laundry.

When the Program was held:

The plan was to release one podcast every two months. Podcast 1: November-December 2021 Podcast 2: December-January 2022

Reflection on the Program:

The main issue with the first podcast is the technical aspect as the members are still discovering and exploring the technical issues such as choosing the platform, deciding the duration, and testing the recording between the interviewers and interviewees.

At the end, we chose Anchor as our main platform, and we uploaded the podcast to Spotify. Another problem occurred is keeping track on the duration. Although we have decided the timestamp, keeping it on the track is quite hard especially when the conversation gets interesting. The connection between the interviewers and interviewees is also something that needs to be taken into account to avoid any disruption in the middle of the recording.

The latter podcast, the struggle was with the location. The second podcast was recorded both in audio and visual form. The problem with visual form is the interviewees and interviewer(s) both need to live in the same city. It was not a

problem for one video, but if the organization wants to do this again in the future, it is better to pick the committees from different cities or regions.

Initially, we actually planned to release two podcasts for this year. However, we also tried to record the third one, but it did not happen. The problem here was the planning of time between the interviewers and the interviewee. As we wanted to have more perspective, we tried to invite different speakers from different region, but we could not find a time that match, especially during the exam sessions.

Improvement for the Future:

As this year's committee have uploaded 2 podcasts, the wish for the future is to continue the podcast with even more frequent uploads. Other suggestions, other than the ones stated in the reflection is to have more diverse topics, especially topics that are usually not covered within the 'formal' media.

Short Description of Program:

• Series 1:

A webinar in which three alumni from various educational backgrounds shared their experiences on how to get a job in Sweden and how to fit into the Swedish working culture. Each speaker gave a lecture based on their own personal experience. The participants were able to elaborate further during a Q&A session at the end of the presentation. Work areas for the speaker include supply chain, medical, and education.

The agenda of the webinar included:

- Talk show and question and answer sessions,

When the Program was held:

Reflection on the Program:

• Series 1:

Overall, the event went well with 25 participants, including speakers and a moderator. The participants were enthusiastic about the topic and asked enough questions to make the event interactive. The event was welltimed, started, and finished on time. One of the presentations ran over time, but this had no impact on the event's duration. The moderator could also effectively lead the discussion.

• Series 2:

The webinar went smoothly even though it had to run with a few changes because there was a very urgent personal matter from one of the speakers. The choice of topic has also been adjusted to the results of a previous survey. Many participants discussed and wanted to know the PhD experience from the three speakers as well as the requirements to become a PhD student. The speakers also explained the diversity of the application process to become a PhD student.

Improvement for the Future:

• Series 1:

It was difficult to inform the speaker that the time limit was almost up because the chat notification did not appear on the presenter's screen. In the future, another method of communication between the timekeeper and the presenter should be considered to make things run more smoothly.

• Series 2:

Improvements for the next webinars could have speakers from other different fields. Participants can be more open to the general public who do not have an educational background in Sweden before. Apart from being a PhD, speakers can be a person who works in another academia sector such as researchers at universities or contribute to policy makers. Collaborating with educational institutions related to doctoral programs at certain universities. Another suggestion is to intensify the publication before the D day.
